


**MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 28, 2018 MEETING OF THE  
BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICE DISTRICT NO. 3**

A special meeting was duly called of the **BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICE DISTRICT NO. 3**, which was held on **August 28, 2018**, at the Danbury Community Center, 6057 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Danbury, Texas 77534.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by **DARRELL VALUSEK**, District President. Those commissioners present were **DARRELL VALUSEK, MIKE JONES, MATT GLAVES, FRANK HAGDORN** and **ROY BEKEN**. Also present were chiefs, directors, and members of the District's fire and emergency medical service providers, members of the public, District Executive Director Dave Ferguson, District legal counsel John Peeler of Coveler & Peeler, P.C. Many members of the public and several elected officials were also present for the town hall workshop.

The Board then conducted a workshop/town hall style meeting to discuss and answer questions from the public regarding the provision of emergency services within the District in 2019 and beyond. First, Mr. Ferguson presented a PowerPoint presentation with background about the District's history, operations and potential plans for the future. A short intermission was then taken in order to allow the public to submit written questions. Mr. Jarrod Smith acted as the moderator for the questions from the public and response from the Board, staff and counsel. The workshop was concluded at 9:03.
