

**A RESOLUTION OF  
BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 3**

**WHEREAS**, the Board understands and appreciates that many of the emergency services providers with whom it contracts for the provision of fire and emergency medical services within the District are not-for-profit corporations capable of receiving charitable donations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board is thankful for the number of hours of service, and sacrifice contributed by volunteer firefighting and emergency medical services personnel within the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board values the support of the community in any form and is thankful that the citizens within the District may offer financial support, from time to time, to the volunteer fire departments and emergency medical services providers within the District; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF BRAZORIA COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 3 THAT:** The District will neither ask nor require emergency services providers, with whom the District holds contracts to provide fire and emergency medical services, to make any proceeds from funds that the provider collects as a result of their charitable status available to, or for the use of, the District. This includes, but is not limited to, donations and proceeds from fundraising events. The District may ask that the independent providers disclose to the District the amount of financial contributions that it receives.
